

Danskin of the USGS about the hydrology and water management alternatives for the San Bernardino area (defined as the Bunker Hill and Lytle Creek basins) for calendar years 1945-1998. This lecture promises to be enlightening for both non-technical and technical audiences that are interested in understanding the water management of an area that has both a high probability of a major earthquake on the San Jacinto or San Andrea Faults and high ground-water levels.
